A1 In Northumberland: Morpeth to Felton Scheme

Notice Publicising a Proposed Application for a Development Consent Order

HIGHWAYS ENGLAND COMPANY LIMITED of Bridge House, 1 Walnut Tree Close, Guildford, GU1 4LZ ("the Applicant") proposes to make an application ("the Application") under Section 37 of the Planning Act 2008 to the Secretary of State for Transport for a Development Consent Order.

The Application is for the proposed improvement to the A1 between Morpeth and Felton in Northumberland.

The scheme's main proposals in summary are:

- Dualling the existing A1 between Warreners Bridge and Priests Bridge at the southern end of the scheme:
- Construction of a new dual carriageway, bypassing west of the existing A1, between Priests Bridge and Burgham Park; and
- Dualling the existing A1 between Burgham Park and Felton at the northern end of the scheme:
- Construction of a new bridge to carry the A1 over the River Coquet parallel to the existing road bridge;
- 3 new split level junctions, which include a bridge over the A1, will be constructed at Highlaws, Fenrother and West Moor;
- Construction of a new bridge over the A1 at Causey Park and construction of a new road under the A1 at Burgham Park; and
- The existing A1 between Priests Bridge and Burgham Park bypassed by the new dual carriageway will become part of the local road network owned and maintained by Northumberland County Council.

The scheme is an Environmental Impact Assessment development ("EIA development"), as defined by The Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2017. An Environmental Statement will be submitted as part of the Application. Preliminary Environmental Information Report ("PEIR") forms part of the consultation material.

Consultation on the proposals will take place from 18 June 2018 to 29 July 2018. Copies of the consultation materials - including documents, plans and maps showing the nature and location of the proposed development and the PEI - will be available for inspection free of charge from 18 June 2018 to 29 July 2018 at the following locations and times:
