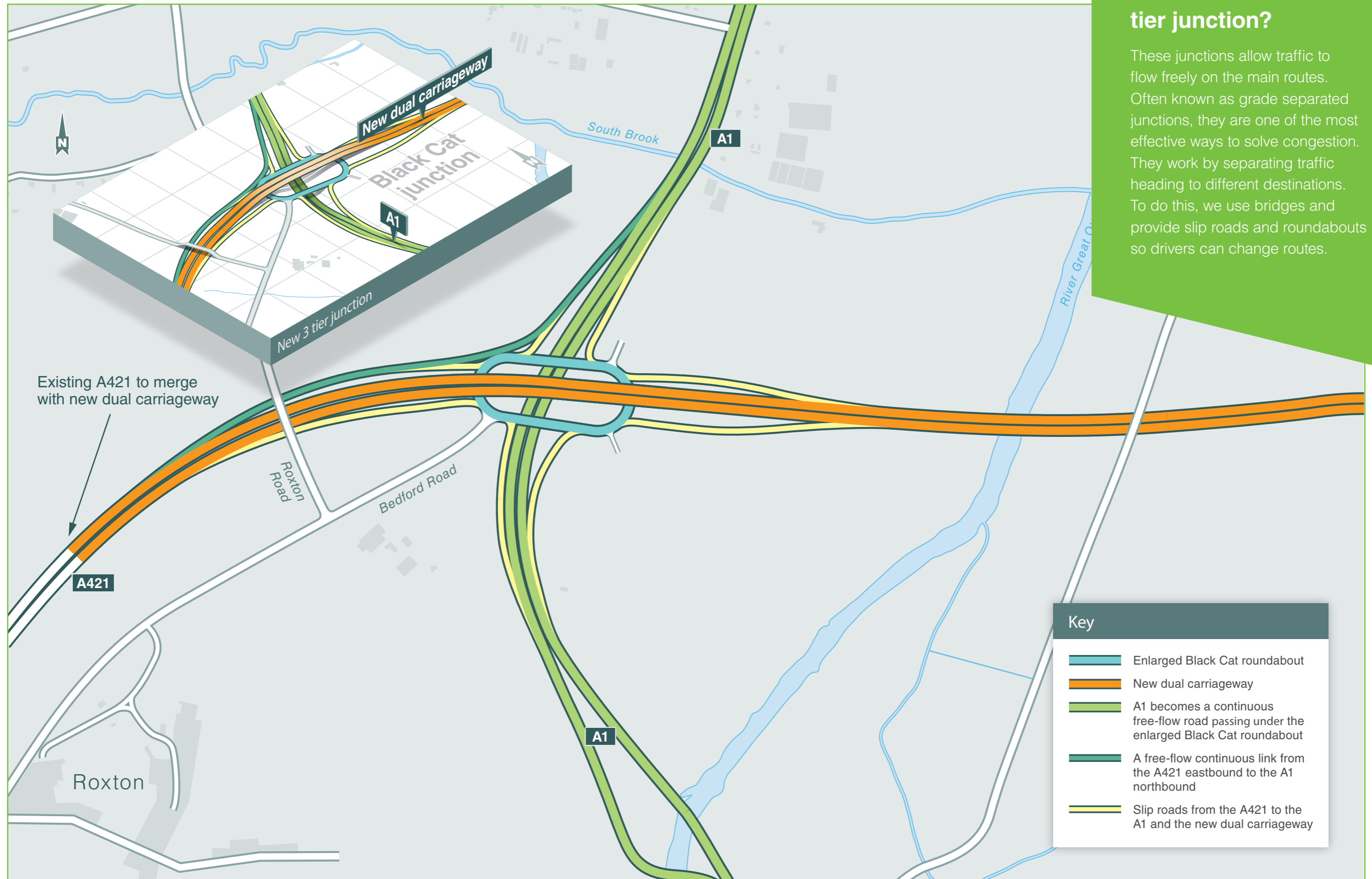


# The preferred route: **Black Cat Option C**



## What is a three tier junction?

These junctions allow traffic to flow freely on the main routes. Often known as grade separated junctions, they are one of the most effective ways to solve congestion. They work by separating traffic heading to different destinations. To do this, we use bridges and provide slip roads and roundabouts so drivers can change routes.

**Key**

- Enlarged Black Cat roundabout
- New dual carriageway
- A1 becomes a continuous free-flow road passing under the enlarged Black Cat roundabout
- A free-flow continuous link from the A421 eastbound to the A1 northbound
- Slip roads from the A421 to the A1 and the new dual carriageway
