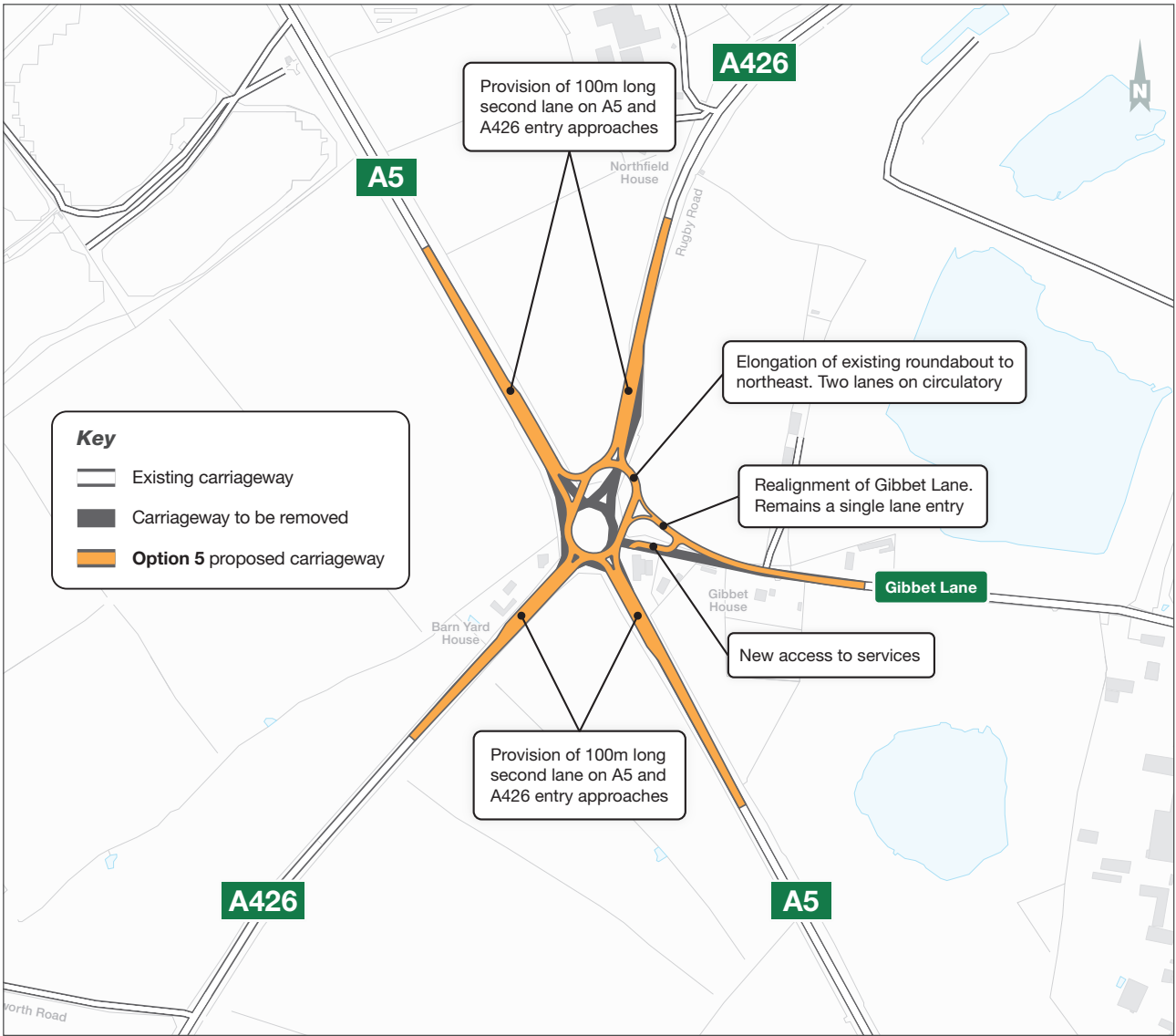

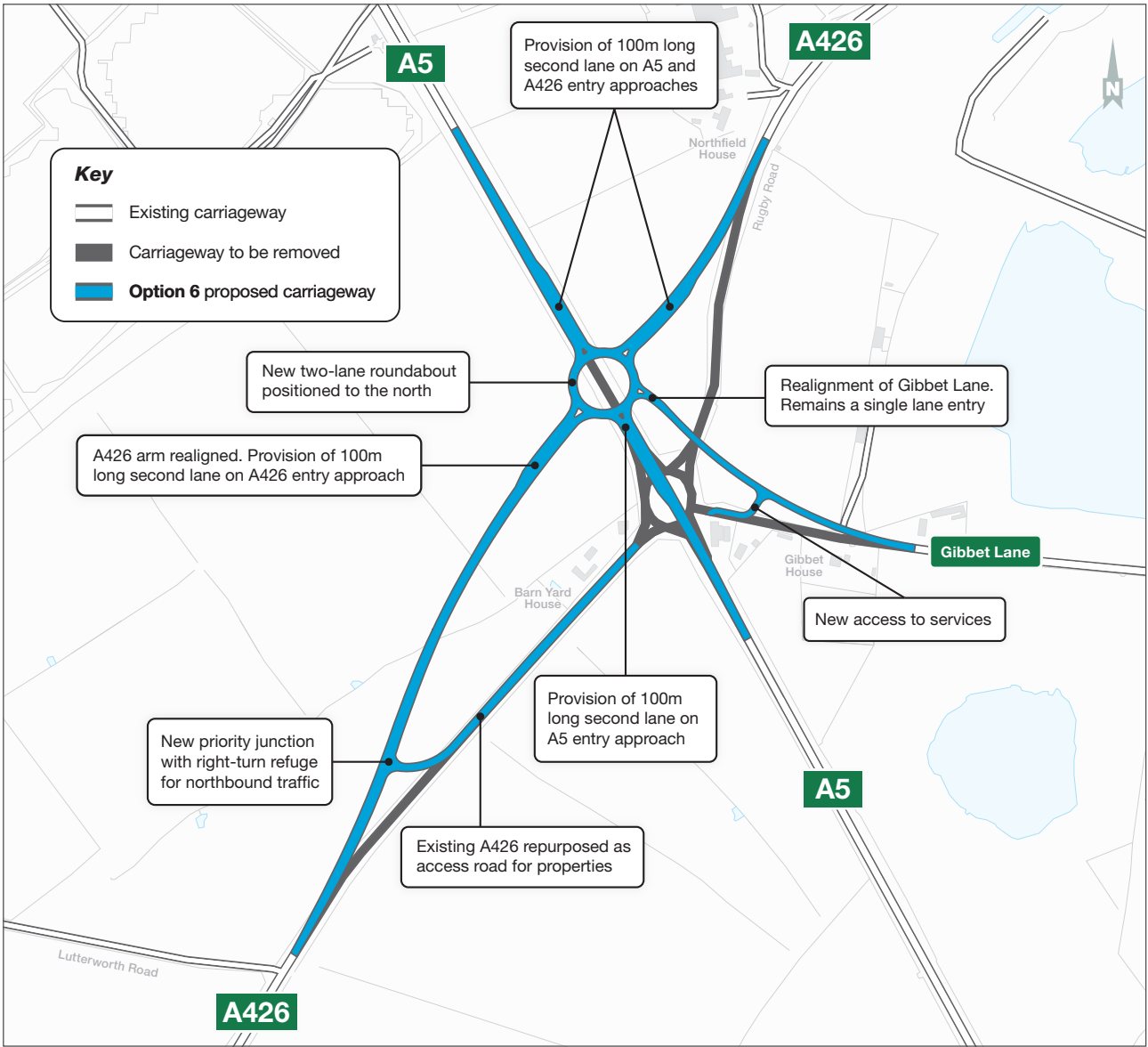

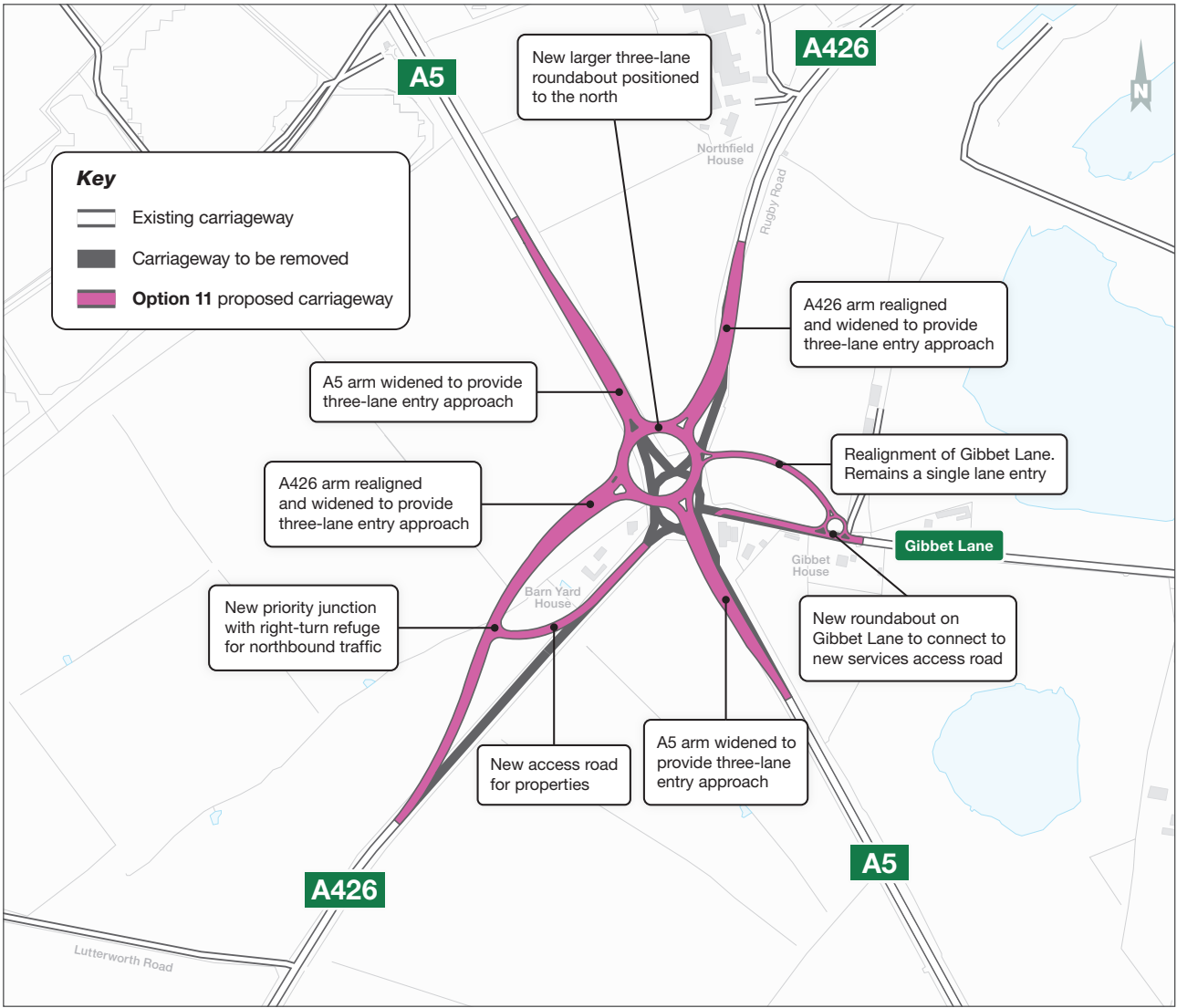

Section 5: Your data, your rights, our responsibility

On 25 May 2018, the United Kingdom General Data Protection Regulations (UK-GDPR) became law. The law requires National Highways to explain to you – consultees, stakeholders and customers – how your personal data will be used and stored.

National Highways adheres to the Gunning Principles, the UK Government’s Consultation Principles, the Planning Act 2008 and the Highways Act 1980 as required and may collect personal data to help shape development of highways schemes.

Personal data collected by the project will be processed and retained by National Highways and its appointed contractors until the scheme is complete.

Under UK GDPR, you have the following rights.

- Right of access to the data (Subject Access Request)
- Right for the rectification of errors
- Right of erasure of personal data - this is not an absolute right under the legislation
- Right to restrict processing or to object to processing
- Right to data portability

If at any point National Highways plans to process the personal data we hold for a purpose other than that for which it was originally collected, we will tell you what that other purpose is. We will do this prior to any further processing taking place and we will include any relevant additional information, including your right to object to that further processing.
