#### M54 to M6 Link Road

## Notice Publicising a Proposed Application for a Development Consent Order

**HIGHWAYS ENGLAND COMPANY LIMITED** of Bridge House, 1 Walnut Tree Close, Guildford, GU1 4LZ ("the Applicant") proposes to make an application ("the Application") under Section 37 of the Planning Act 2008 to the Secretary of State for Transport for a Development Consent Order.

The Application is for the proposed M54 to M6 Link Road in South Staffordshire.

The scheme's main proposals in summary are:

To provide a new link road that will improve journey times and reliability on the motorway and local road networks. The scheme will include:

- A new link road of approximately 2.5 km (1.6 miles) in length between the M54 junction 1 and the M6 junction 11
- A new junction at M54 junction 1 to provide direct links to and from the M54 and the new link road and to maintain the connections to the local road network
- Realignment of Hilton Lane over the new link road
- A new junction at M6 Junction 11 with junction capacity improvements and changes proposed to Mill Lane
- In addition, any necessary rights and powers will be sought to ensure delivery of the Scheme, including compulsory acquisition.

The scheme is an Environmental Impact Assessment development ("EIA development"), as defined by The Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2017. An Environmental Statement will be submitted as part of the Application. Preliminary Environmental Information ("PEI") forms part of the consultation material.

Consultation on the proposals will take place from 24 May 2019 to 5 July 2019. Copies of the consultation materials - including documents, plans and maps showing the nature and location of the proposed development and the PEI - will be available for inspection free of charge during the consultation at the following locations and times:
