What we are consulting on

Our proposal is for a new road which would connect the A2/M2 in Kent with a tunnel crossing east of Gravesend and Tilbury (known as Option C in the 2013 consultation), before joining the M25 between junctions 29 and 30.

There are three route options north of the river in Essex and two south of the river in Kent (shown on the map on the front cover).

Your views will inform the Government's decision on which route would be built. This decision is expected later this year.
